### **RAM MOT Evening with Mike Glover from Torch Farm Vets**

#### **Key Points**

- Pre Topping MOT – 10 weeks prior (August time)
- Move away from fat rams – risk of poor fertility
- You want a FIT not FAT Ram
- Antibiotics will not affect fertility
- You want a ram that moves well, will find ewes and two testicles.
- Teeth must be good, cheek teeth do the chewing
- Check brisket – sores from raddles
- Don't be afraid to clip Scrotum – air to circulate
- Ideal condition score – between 3 and 3.5
- Fibre and a protein diet are important
